

The self-admitted policy of most car and other vehicle manufacturers that they knowingly restrict and/or prohibit their US-based dealers from selling to Canadians and further they penalize any Canadian purchasing in the US by denying warranties etc is a clear and deliberate anti-competitive practice.

I ask that the Policy Review Panel make it a priority to review these practices and to issue findings and recommendations as soon as possible. Canadians are being ripped off and have been for the past year or more. I urge the Panel to issue a highly public statement saying they are initiating the review and will issue a preliminary report shortly followed by a more detailed analysis and recommendations. I feel strongly that this will persuade the auto manufacturers & other sectors to take action sooner than later on a voluntary basis to align Canada & US prices.
